Did you know that homework help is just a few mouse clicks away? Funding from the North Dakota State Library, with aid and support provided by the Institute of Museum and Library Services, Washington, D.C. provides the Dickinson Area Public Library access to a national on-line tutoring service. Tutor ND may be accessed at the Dickinson Area Public Library or from any computer or device with an Internet connection. Access to www.tutorND.com is free and the services available are numerous. Tutor ND is available Sunday through Thursday evenings, from 6:00 PM to 10:00 PM Central time. During these availability times students can experience one-on-one help from certified tutors online. These tutors have expertise in all core academic subjects including math, science, social studies, and English. Students can communicate with a professional tutor in real time. Experienced tutors will conduct sessions with students that provide answers through written as well as visual demonstrations. Most importantly this service is for all our community members including college students and adults.

Students and job seekers get immediate feedback, writing tips, and strategies as well as proofreading assistance by utilizing a shared whiteboard and the live chat functionality. In addition , Tutor ND includes 24/7 access to thousands of resources including study guides, worksheets, and videos on topics in math, science, social studies, English, resume writing, GED prep, citizenship exam prep, and more.
